# Safety Instructions and Warnings

#### Read all instructions before use:

The appliance is not to be used by children. Persons with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge may only use this appliance if they are supervised or have been given instruction about how to use it safely and understand what risks are involved. Children should be supervised to ensure they do not play with the device.

#### **Notice and Warnings:**


- Please take it gently and carefully to avoid breaking the device.
- Please don't use it close to fire source or in any location of high temperature.
- Don't use or keep the cleaner in extreme climate conditions, e.g. cooling rooms, high temperature environment, suggested temperature of using and storage is 0-40°C (32-104°F) of indoor areas;
- Check the power cable and confirm it is in good condition.
- Please make sure the filter set is installed properly.
- Do not use outdoors or on wet surfaces, use only on dry, indoor surfaces.
- Do not allow to be used as a toy. Close attention is necessary when used near children.
- Use only as described in this manual. Use only manufacturer's recommended attachments.
- Do not use vacuum if it has been dropped, damaged, left outdoors, or dropped in water. Return it to an authorized service center.
- Do not handle plug or appliance with wet hands.
- Do not put any object into openings. Do not use with any opening blocked; keep free of dust, lint, hair and anything that may reduce air flow.
- Keep hair, loose clothing, fingers, and all parts of body away from openings and moving parts.
- Do not pick up anything that is burning or smoking, such as cigarettes, matches, or got ashes.
- Use extra care when cleaning on stairs.
- Do not use to pick up flammable or combustible liquids such as gasoline or use in areas where they may be present.
- Look on your vacuum and follow all label and marking instructions.
- Keep end of hose, wands and other openings away from your face and body.
- Do not use the vacuum cleaner without dust box filter in place.
- Always unplug this appliance before connecting or disconnecting vacuum hose.
- Store the vacuum indoors. Put the vacuum away after to prevent tripping accidents.
- Use the incorrect battery will damage motor and users. Please use the original batteries.
- Do not use for any purpose other than described in this user's guide.
- If the supply cord is damaged, it must be replaced by the manufacturer, its service agent or similarly qualified persons in order to avoid a hazard.
- Don't use the cleaner in or near flammable or explosive conditions.
- Don't use your cleaner to suck glass particles, needle, water, ashes, or any other liquids.
- Don't use your cleaner to suck cement, land plaster, wall plaster or toys, which may cause defects to the device.
- Don't block the exhaust air outlet of the docking station.
- If the cleaner can't start working even when the battery is full, please go to service agent or Mamibot distributors for inspection, don't disassemble it on your own.


- Don't use the cleaner if dust box and filter set are not in position.
- Dry cloth is suggested to clean the cleaner, no gas/alcohol or other chemical solution is allowed to clean the device.
- Turn off the cleaner first before proceeding with any cleaning task or maintenance.
- Please clean the dust box, suction inlet and tube in time to avoid air channel being blocked, air channel blockage would reduce suction power and cause motor heating.
- Hepa filter is suggested to be replaced in three month, or even in shorter period if the device is frequently used.

#### Application of Power Adapter / Plug and Batteries

- Use only the original power adapter or plug supplied with this device. Use of other type of power adapter or plug will result in malfunction and/or danger.
- Please use the proper electric outlet and make sure no heavy objects are placed on the power adapter or power cord / plug.
- Allow adequate ventilation around the adapter / plug when using it to operate the device. Do not cover the power adapter / plug with objects that will reduce cooling.
- Do not use the adapter / plug in a high moisture environment. Never handle the adapter / plug with wet hands.
- Connect the adapter / plug to a proper power source. The voltage requirements are found on the adapter or the rating label.
- Do not use broken adapter, power cord or plug. The plug must be removed from the receptacle before cleaning or maintaining the appliance. Do not unplug the power adapter / plug by pulling on the power cord.
- Do not attempt to service the adapter / plug. There are no service parts inside. Replace the whole unit if it is damaged or exposed to high moisture. Consult your Mamibot dealer for help and maintenance.
- Do not short contact the charging pins on the docking station in case of injury.
- The battery used in this device may present a risk of fire or chemical burn if mistreated. Do not disassemble, short contact, heat above  $40^{\circ}$  (104  $^{\circ}$  ), or incinerate.
- Please charge your cleaner at least every three months if you are not using it regularly.
- Fully charge the cleaner before use if it's not used for long time.
- If you have to dispose of this old equipment, please take it to the local recycling center for recycling electrical and electronic parts.
- Retain the safety and operating instructions for future reference.
- Do not expose your device to rain or excess humidity, and keep it away from liquids (such as beverages, faucets, and so on).
- Avoid exposing your device to direct sunlight or intense light source, and keep it away from heat source (such as radiators, space heaters, stoves, and so on).
- On waxed floors the movement of the cleaner head may create an uneven lustre. If this happens, wipe with a damp cloth, polish the area with wax, and wait for it to dry.
- The appliance must be disconnected from the receptacle before removing the battery for disposal of the appliance.
- The battery must be used in accordance with the directions in this Instruction manual.








A red light warns of a roller brush blockage.

- Lt glows solid white to confirm Quiet mode is selected.
- It glows solid white to confirm Standard mode is selected.
- It glows solid white to confirm Max mode is selected.
- It flashes white during charging, turns solid white once fully charged.
- The cleaner defaults to Auto mode upon startup, indicated by a red light. It will automatically adjust the suction power based on the level of dirt detected.
- The indicator light turns red to alert you that the dust box is full or the pipe is clogged.
- After starting the cleaner, press the button to cycle through the working modes.


# Tips:



#### **Battery Pack**

**Initial Use:** Insert the battery pack into the V12 and ensure it is fully charged before first use.

**Specifications:** Only use original battery packs. It is recommended to replace the battery pack after one year of use for optimal performance. **Disposal:** Before disposing of the V12 unit, the battery pack must be removed. Dispose of the used battery pack at designated recycling points or institutions in accordance with all local environmental regulations.




#### **Motorized Head**

Connecting the to the metal tube and main unit before use. It is mainly used for floor cleaning.



#### 2IN1 Wide Brush

This accessory connects directly to the main unit or an extension tube, making it ideal for cleaning hard-to-reach areas. It is perfect for ceilings, curtains, sofas, desks, keyboards, and other confined spaces.



# **Long Crevice Brush**

It can be attached directly to the main unit or an extension tube to clean corners, sofa crevices, car interiors, and other confined, hard-to-reach spaces.




## **Cleaning Tool**


This tool is designed for two primary maintenance functions: it cuts away hair wrapped around the roller brush, and cleans key components such as the cleaner head, dust box, HEPA filter, and metal filter.

# **Assembling & Disassembling**

1. To assemble or disassemble V12, please follow the instructions as below:




- 1). Insert the battery pack into the main unit (1), until you hear the "click" sound.
- \* Press the battery pack release button, users can pull battery pack out to detach. The battery pack must be removed from V12 before it is scrapped.
- 2). Connecting the main unit and metal tube for cleaner (2), until you hear the "click" sound.
- 3). Connecting the motorized head with metal tube (3), until you hear "click" sound.
- 2. Users can also connect the other brushes according to usage:



#### Notes:

- Make sure the connection is tighten before use.
- Press the release buttons to disassemble the main unit, metal tube and brushes.

- 3. To assemble or disassemble the docking station:
- 1). Insert the docking station main unit to the base until you hear the "click" sound ①.
- 2). Insert the metal tube for the station to the docking station main until you hear the "click" sound ②.
- 3). Insert the bracket to the metal tube top for the station until you hear the "click" sound  $\ensuremath{\Im}$  .
- 4). Press the release buttons hard to disassemble the parts accordingly.



# Charging

#### 1.How to recharge

- 1). Place the V12 on the docking station DSV12.
- 2). After ensuring there is no visible wear and tear and all connections are secure, plug in the unit to charge it.

#### 2.Battery Indicator 🗓

- 1). The battery indicator will flash red when the battery capacity is lower than 10%.
- 2). It turns solid white once the battery full charged.

#### Note:

- Please fully charge the battery before intitial use.
- V12 can not be switched on during charging.
- Only use the original adapter / plug to recharge.
- Do not touch the device and plug with wet hands in case of any dangers.



- 1. Power On: Remove the cleaner from the docking station. Press the power switch "8" to turn on the V12. The device will default to Auto mode.
- 2.Select Mode: Press the mode button  $\bigcirc$  to cycle through the available suction levels.
- 3. Power Off: Press the power button again at any mode to switch the device off.
- 4. Woking Mode Guide:

**Auto Mode (Default):** The machine automatically adjusts suction power based on the detected floor surface and level of soiling.

**Quiet Mode:** Provides low suction power and minimized noise operation, ideal for lightly soiled floors or quiet environments.

**Standard Mode:** Delivers balanced suction power and moderate noise for everyday cleaning.

**MAX Mode:** Activates maximum suction power and higher noise level for intensive cleaning of heavily soiled areas.

5. Note: The battery life (working time) varies depending on the selected suction mode and the attached brush tool.

#### **Important Safety Notes**


**WARNING**: Do not activate the vacuum while checking for or clearing blockages, as this may cause personal injury.

**Indoor & Automotive Use Only**: Designed for use indoors and in stationary vehicles. Do not use outdoors or in moving vehicles.

**Keep Dry**: Never operate the vacuum on wet surfaces or immerse any part of the unit in water.

# Storage

- 1. Assembling the cleaner properly before storage, then place it on the docking station properly.
- 2. The storage temperature must be  $0-40^{\circ}$  (32-104°F).
- 3. Charge the cleaner regularly (approx. every 3 months) if you do not use it for a long time.
- 4. Store the cleaner in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight.



#### Maintenance and Clean

- To ensure a better performance of the V12 cleaning, please maintain and clean it regularly.
- Please unplug the power source, switch off V12 before maintenance and clean.

## 1.Empty the Dust Box


#### 1).Auto-Empty

- (1). Plug the docking station and press the dust collection switch to "I" to turn the auto-empty on.
- (2). Place the cleaner on the docking station properly, then the docking station will empty the dust box automatically.
- (3). If the dust box becomes overloaded with heavy dust or hair, empty it multiple times or clean it out manually.
- (4). User can press the dust collection switch to "O" to turn the auto-empty off.

#### 2). Manual Emptying


- (1). Detach the Main Unit: Firmly press the top metal tube release button and remove the main unit.
- (2). Empty the Dust Box: Press the dust box lid release button to open it and release the debris. Typically, this is all that is required to empty the dust box. Once empty, close the lid securely.

Warning: Do not wash the main unit with water.



# 2.Roller Brush & Suction Inlet Cleaning


- 1). Unlock the roller brush lock button, and remove the roller brush.
- 2). Clean dust, hair, fabric particles on the roller brush with the cleaning tool, cut hair or other wrapping around the brush if it is tangled.
- 3). Cleaning the front scroll wheels and back scroll wheels with cleaning tool or soft mop.
- 4). Replace the roller brush according to usage.
- 5). Clean the suction inlet with the cleaning tool.



# 3. Filter Set Cleaning

- 1). Press the dust box lid release button, empty the debris.
- 2). Hold and press the dust box release button, rotate counterclockwise and then remove the dust box.
- 3). Hold the filter set and rotate clockwise, then remove the filter set.
- 4). Hold the filter set handle and rotate counterclockwise, then remove the Hepa.
- 5). Clean the dust box with the cleaning tool, clean the Hepa and metal filter with the cleaning tool and cool water, then dry them completely before next use.

**Notes**: There are electronic components inside the dust box. Do not rinse with water.










# 4. Remove & Replace the Dust Bag.

- 1). Remove the dust collection lid.
- 2). Pull up the dust bag and out, then dispose of it in the trash.
- 3). Insert the new dust bag into the slot, push it in firmly until it is fully seated, and then close the lid.







# Recommended frequency for cleaning or replacement

Parts	Recommendations
Roller Brush	Clean every 2-3 times use; Replac every 3-6 months use.
Hepa Filter	Clean every 1-2 times use; Replac every 3-6 months use.
Metal Filter	Clean every 1-2 times use.
Dust Box	Clean after each use.
Dust Bag	Replace every 1-2 months use.
Battery Pack	Replace every 6-12 months use.
Scroll Wheels	Clean every 2-3 times use.

#### Note:

Above recommendations are only for your reference. The final frequency for cleaning or replacment should subject to the usage.

# **Troubleshooting**

If your V12 cordless vacuum cleaner is not working properly, please try the solutions below. If none of them solve the problem, please contact an authorized agent for inspection and repair.
